- Eligibility to apply for CAL FIRE Basic Firefighter
- High School credits may be applied to graduation (contact your high school counselor to verify)

### Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age by June 1, 2019
- Pass Category I, arduous physical work medical exam recommended
- Student must have all leather boots & gloves
- CCOE/CTE provides educational opportunities without regard to race, color, national origin, accent, religion, political affiliation, sex, age, or handicap

- 1/4/2019 to 3/24/2019
- Fridays: 5:30-9:30pm; 8-5pm Sat. & Sun.—total: 240 hours

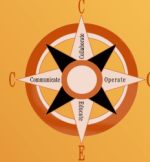

## The Basic Wildland Firefighter Training Program

Is a Career Technical Education to prepare students for a career in the public service industry sector.

### This Program Will Provide the Opportunity to Earn

- CAL FIRE Basic Wildland Firefighter Certificate
- NWCG S-190, S-130, L-180, ICS-100
- Emergency Care Provider CPR Certificate D.O.T. First Responder EMS Certification CCOE/CTE Certificate of Completion

The Basic Wild-land Firefighter Training Program will provide quality instruction for all students qualifying them to earn up to 18 CAL FIRE certifications and eligibility for potential employment starting June 1, 2019.

## Adults & High School Students, Who are age 18 by June 1, 2019

The program has a maximum limit of 30 students, and priority registration will be given to graduating high school seniors.

### Course Fees:

- Tuition—\$1,200.

### Additional costs:

- Applicants are responsible for all costs associated with physical evaluation and inoculations
- Applicants must purchase their own uniform pants & shirts and wear undamaged 100% leather boots and gloves during the course.
